Process Cycle Efficiency is a Lean Six Sigma metric useful for prioritizing improvement opportunities. Process Cycle Efficiency is calculated by dividing the value-added time associated with a process by the total lead time of the process. $\text{Process Cycle Efficiency} = \frac{\text{Value-Added Time}}{\text{Lead Time}}$. If the process consists of only value-added activities, then the Process Cycle Efficiency would reach a theoretical maximum of 100%.

For example, take the hypothetical process below: The process above has a cycle time of 860 seconds. So, the Process Cycle Efficiency could then be calculated by doing the following: $\text{Process Cycle Efficiency} = \frac{182}{860} = .21$, or 21%. In other words, only 21% of the process above is considered value-added to the customer.

The process cycle efficiency helps to detect how much of the process is actually adding value to the entire process. It is calculated by using the following formula: $\text{Process Cycle Efficiency} = \frac{\text{Value-added time}}{\text{Cycle time}}$. The process cycle efficiency varies in application, but a process is considered lean when the process cycle efficiency is above 25 per cent.
