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The slope indicates the steepness of a line and the intercept indicates the location where it intersects an axis. The slope and the intercept define the linear relationship between two variables, and can be used to estimate an average rate of change. The greater the magnitude of the slope, the steeper the line and the greater the rate of change.

When an equation is in slope-intercept form, the slope is the number in front of the x. This means the slope is $\frac{1}{4}$. A line with a slope of $\frac{1}{4}$ will go up 1 and over to the right 4. The y-intercept is the constant at the end. Pay close attention to the sign of the

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y-intercept. This equation has a minus sign, so the y-intercept is -1.

In this case its linear equation can be written $y = mx + y_0$. If, moreover, the line is not horizontal, it can be defined by its slope and its x-intercept x_0 . In this case, its equation can be written

To fit the best fit line we have to optimise the slope of the line and the intercept of the line. For simplicity, we take a constant slope of 0.64, so that we can understand how gradient descent would optimise the intercept.
