A compound-complex sentence is one that contains at least two independent clauses and one dependent clause, such as: While I have no preference, she loves jumping, and he loves ducking. Here, 'While I have no preference' is a dependent clause (i.e. 'while' implies a comparison, so the clause is not a complete sentence by itself).
