Definitions. Fixed bridge: A dental prosthesis that is definitively attached to natural teeth and replaces missing teeth.. Abutment: The tooth that supports and retains a dental prosthesis.. Pontic: The artificial tooth that replaces a missing natural tooth.. Retainer: The component attached to the abutment for retention of the prosthesis.Retainers can be major or minor.
