Swan Lake National Wildlife Refuge is a great place for seeing a variety of birds. The most commonly seen birds are waterfowl and shorebirds. The best viewing for waterfowl is during the spring migration, where nearly every waterfowl species in the Central Flyway can be seen using the refuge's wetlands.

Swan River National Wildlife Refuge (NWR) was acquired by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service in 1973 to be managed for the benefit of migratory birds. This 1,568 acre Refuge is part of the Benton Lake National Wildlife Refuge Complex and is administered by the Refuge staff at Benton Lake NWR located just north of Great Falls, Montana. Nestled between the Swan Mountains to the east and the Mission Mountains to the west, the Refuge lies south of Swan Lake, within the Swan River flood plain.

About the Refuge - Swan River - U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service

There is no telephone at the Swan Creek Range itself. The Swan Creek WMA Shooting Range range provides shooting opportunities at distances up to 100 yards. There are four ranges (25, 50, 100 yards) located side by side with a dividing berm to allow shooters to go down range independently of each other. An area to shoot shotguns at clay targets is located to the north of the 100 yard rifle range.

The refuge includes 7,440 acres of wetlands, grasslands, and forests along the eastern edge of the Missouri River floodplain. Overlooking the refuge from the east, the Loess Hills habitat is a geological formation of fine silt deposited after the past glacial period.
