Back to Basics - Building Solutions in Visual Studio ...

Visual Studio can find an assembly when given a path to the project. When you have a project that produces an assembly, you should reference the project and not use a file reference (see below). The advantage of a project-to-project reference is that it creates a dependency between the projects in the build system.

A key difference from older Visual Studio templates for new projects is that the FSharp.Core version is now always a NuGet package. F# is installed by default with any .NET Workload. InstallShield MSI setup: Installer projects created in Visual Studio 2010 can be opened in later versions with the help of the Visual Studio Installer Projects extension.

Unload projects in Solution Folder is no longer available ...

The "Manage NuGet Packages for Solution" shows an aggregate of all the projects. When installing a package, you must still select which projects to install them in. It provides a convenient location to automatically update or install packages across multiple projects. When you manage packages for a single project you get a project-only view.

What is the difference between "Managing Nuget Packages ...

The difference is the way the build and clean sequence happens for every project. Let's say your solution has two projects, "proj1" and "proj2". If you do a rebuild it will take "proj1", clean (delete) the compile files for "proj1" and build it.

What Is The Difference Between Build, Rebuild And Clean In ...

Visual Studio Comparison Tools is an extension for Visual Studio which uses external tools to compare files, folders and clipboard. Features: Comparing two files, selecting folders for comparison from the solution explorer and comparing (and merging) clipboard to a file or selected area in a file.
